FEDERATIONS INVITED

The Pan American Gymnastics Union invites all Federations affiliated to the PAGU and the FIG and which are up to date in their obligations.

AGE LIMITS

WAG: 16 years and older*

MAG: 18 years and older* (18 years old MAG gymnasts who chose to compete as juniors in 2023 are not allowed to participate in this competition). *Ages as of December 31, 2023

All gymnasts must have a valid FIG licence until the end of the event.

QUALIFICATION FOR OTHER EVENTS

This Championship will serve as qualifier event for the following competitions:

- Artistic Gymnastics World Championships Antwerp 2023
- XIX Pan American Games Santiago 2023

JUDGES AND JURIES

All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet at the time of the event, for the respective discipline.

Each Federation must register 1 judge if participates with 1-2 gymnasts (individuals) and 2 judges if participates with 3-5 gymnasts (teams).

The Federations can register a second judge (for individuals) or a third judge (for teams), different from the PAGU TC Member as additional accredited person, with no cost for this accreditation. Provision of max. 1 judge per NF per panel. The fine for not registering the required number of judges in each discipline is

USD\$1,000.00 per missing judge. The Federations with a PAGU TC Member can register that Member in addition to their official judges.

The fines for not registering the required number of judges must be paid to PAGU by <u>March 26, 2023</u> at the latest and it does not apply to those Federations that do not have FIG brevet judges in the respective discipline (MAG, WAG) and that this is the first cycle in which they participate in PAGU competitions.

The National Federation must inform PAGU at the time of the definitive registration (March 26, 2023) to allow the appointment of invited neutral judges.

ENTRY FEES

The entry fee for this event is <u>USD\$50.00</u> per gymnast (including the reserve gymnast) and per discipline. It must be paid to the Local Organizing Committee ("LOC") by **March 26, 2023** at the latest.

The cost of the accreditation for additional Delegation Members is **USD\$100.00** per person and must be paid to the LOC by <u>March 26, 2023</u> at the latest.

Only the following persons can receive an additional accreditation: Coach (as per PAGU TR), Doctor, Physiotherapist, Team Manager.

The accreditations of the second judge (individuals) or third judge (teams) different from PAGU TC Member have no cost.

ACCREDITATION

Once the definitive registration period has ended (March 26, 2023) the COL will deliver to each registered Federation the user and the SportEvents password (https://sportevents.com.co).

Along with the nominative registration all the Federations must upload to the PAGU intranet a copy of the passport and a photograph of each delegation member:

Additionally, the Federations must upload the information of their delegation (names, function, photos, etc.) to SportEvents.

Requirements for the photos:

- File format: JPEG
- Dimensions: min 210 x 270 pixels; max 420 x 540 pixels
- 3.5 cm width x 4.5 cm high
- File size: no more than 1 MB
- White background

Each document must be identified with the Country Code, Last name, First Name, Competition (MAG, WAG) and function of each member.

This documentation must be uploaded on SportEvents and on the PAGU intranet no later than **April 26, 2023**.

In case of not uploading the photograph as requested, the Local Organizing Committee can take the photograph during the registration and will have an additional cost of **USD\$10.00** for each one.

In case of theft or loss of accreditation, it must be informed immediately to the Local Organization Committee for the cancellation of the accreditation.

The replacement of stolen or lost accreditation will cost **USD\$50.00** to be covered by the accreditation holder.

Accreditation will be distributed upon arrival at the registration desk.

More information on the access zones for each accreditation will be given in the Work Plan.

In addition, the LOC will distribute information regarding the gymnasts' safeguarding plan.

EVENT FORMAT

The competition will follow the FIG rules for Senior category.

2 days of competition per discipline

- Day 1: MAG Qualification (MAG All-Around and Apparatus awards) (*)
- Day 2: WAG Qualification (WAG All-Around and Apparatus awards) (*)
- Day 3: MAG & WAG Teams Finals

(*) The Qualification Competition will determine the individual "All-Around" places and Teams for Artistic Gymnastics World Championships Antwerp 2023 and XIX Pan American Games Santiago 2023 will be based on the results of this competition.

VISA

The LOC will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before **April 26, 2023** to the LOC.

the Federations prior to the event.

The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.

The request can be made at SportEvents after the definitive registration and no later than **April 26, 2023**.

INSURANCE

The host Federation, the LOC, the PAGU and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation and the like.

The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.

In order to benefit from the subsidiary insurance coverage of the FIG IMSSA, it is compulsory to have basic insurance in the country of residence (illness, accident and repatriation).

The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance, no later than **April 26, 2023**. The LOC will offer insurance to the Federations, at their expense, at a cost of: **USD\$100.00** per person for all the official days of the event. If requested after this date (**April 26, 2023**), the total cost will be **USD\$150.00** per person for the official days of the event.

The request can be made at SportEvents after the definitive registration and no later than **April 26, 2023**.

INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION

The invited participating Federations must pay for the international travel costs of their delegation members.

International Airport of arrival

José María Córdova International Airport (MDE)

Travel itinerary information must be provided to LOC via SportEvent no later than **April 26, 2023**.

LOCAL TRANSPORTATION

Local transportation will be offered to and from the airport, provided that the delegations stay in one of the official hotels and book their accommodation through the Local Organizing Committee.

The Local Organizing Committee will provide local transportation from the airport to the hotel and vice versa, only on the official arrival day of Monday, May 22, and on the official departure day of Monday, May 29 (except for PAGU representatives arriving or departing on different days).

The request for local transport on the official dates can be made at SportEvents after the definitive registration and no later than **April 26, 2023**.

For delegations that arrive or return on non-official days, transportation to their accommodation (official hotels) or to the airport will cost <u>USD\$30.00</u> per person per trip (airport-hotel or hotel-airport). The request must be made at SportEvents and paid no later than <u>April 26, 2023</u>.

The Local Organizing Committee will provide transportation from the official hotels to the competition facilities and vice versa, for all members of the delegation duly accredited and according to the official program of activities, as long as it is necessary due to rain.
